Fin Front Spar Modification.

Serial Numbers Affected:

24-1 to 24-5047 Inclusive. 26-2 to 26-148 Inclusive.

At the owners/operators discretion.

Airworthiness Directive No. 75-12-06 requires a repetitive inspection of the fin front spar to fuselage attachment channel bend relief holes for evidence of cracks; repair or replace cracked channel/straps if cracks are detected, etc.

Currently, it is necessary to physically remove the fin to gain visual access to the channel relief holes, as the fin front spar extends over the relief holes by approximately 1/2 to 2/3 of the relief hole diameter.

To eliminate removal of the fin and to enable an easy visual inspection, the fin front spar may be modified in accordance with the sketch/instruction sheet contained on the reverse side of this release.

## NOTE:

A.D. 75-12-06 refers to "channel part number 20749-0" and "straps part number 20749-5 and -6": these items are <u>not</u> listed in the PA-24 Parts Catalog, as they are components of Fuselage Bulkhead Assembly part number 20475-00 (PA-24-180 and 250), 20475-05 (PA-24-260) and 22904-00 (PA-24-400).


